

CALL FOR SPECIAL ELECTION AND NOTICE OF QUALIFYING

Based upon a resolution of the Dawsonville City Council dated December 4, 2017 calling for a Special Election pursuant to O.C.G.A. §21-2-540 and the City Charter to fill the unexpired term of Mayor James Grogan, who was removed from office, please take notice that the City of Dawsonville as assisted by the Dawson County Board of Elections will hold a Special Election for the office of Mayor on March 20, 2018.

Qualification dates for the Special Election for Mayor are set for January 8, 2018 beginning at 9:00 a.m. through 4:30 p.m. each day concluding on January 11, 2018 at the Office of the Dawson County Board of Elections, located at 96 Academy Avenue, Dawsonville, Georgia 30534. The Qualification Fee for Mayor is \$720.00 made payable by check or money order to the City of Dawsonville.

The individual elected as Mayor of the City of Dawsonville will be sworn into office on April 9, 2018 at the monthly Council meeting and will serve until December 31, 2019 or until his/her successor is duly elected and sworn into office.

All persons who are not registered to vote and who desire to register to vote in the special election may register to vote through the close of business on February 20, 2018. Polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. on the Special Election Day of March 20, 2018.
